## A BYE IS A WIN!

Therefore, the contestant with a by automatically goes into the next round as a winner. Generally, that contestant will fight another contestant who also received a bye.

1- In a general policy, those who register first would be entitled to a bye.
2- In certain circumstances, bye distribution would change in order to prevent one school/ dojo from receiving all the byes in case of multiple byes ie 3 or more byes.
